Building Code Hint of the Week: Required Labeling

According to **Jack Glenn**, Technical Services Director for the **Florida Home Builders Association**, there is a new provision, **M1502.6 Duct length**, in the new supplement for the *Florida Building Code, Residential*. The provision requires a **permanent label** when the booster fan is installed in an area not readily accessible from the **room with the dryer**. The label must say, "This dryer exhaust system is equipped with a remotely located booster fan". Presumably, 'permanent' would mean a durable label attached to the wall in the room of the dryer.
